

Spotlight on benefits

✓ Simpler, higher quality processes

By using SMART devices, we aim to reduce the need for printed documents, including pocket notebooks, process offence paperwork and court documents. This includes re-engineering 15 initial processes, reducing cost and improving the time taken to complete processes resulting in **financial savings in excess of £500,000 by 2019.**



Digital skills survey

The digital skills survey has proven popular with more than 60% of the force completing it so far. Results are already pointing to **high levels of digital literacy**, with two-thirds of respondents indicating confidence in their IT skills. 90% use a touchscreen device daily and 98% express comfort with IT change. Overall a great platform for a successful move to new mobile ways of working!

Building understanding of the changes

The SMARTPolice project team attended this year's Tech Fair to promote the project's goals and current status. The team received some great comments and feedback on the approach being taken to modernise Jersey's policing. This exercise has helped raise awareness of the changes coming.
