

Keeping Children Safe

Your Right To Ask

The majority of child sexual offences are committed by someone known to the victim.

If you have a concern about someone who has contact with a child you know, you can ask the police about them. If that individual has a record for child sexual offences, the police will consider sharing this information with the person best placed to protect the child – usually the child’s parent, carer or guardian – and work with them to protect the child.
