**Property Marking. What's the point?**

Property marking by itself cannot prevent a theft from happening but it can act as a deterrent to most thieves. Marking your valuables with your postcode and house number increases the chance of recovering your property, should you be the victim of a crime. For example if you live in 9 West Albion Street, Notown NT42 9WA you would mark your property NT42 9WA 9. If the property had the name Rose Cottage instead of a number you would mark it as NT42 9WA RO.

Use this card and also the card on the reverse to keep a hard copy of what you have marked. This will be of great benefit to the Police should you be unfortunately a victim of theft. It will also assist you in "proof of ownership" issues when property is recovered

**General items record card**

Use this card to keep a note of the items, in your home or garden that you have marked. It will be useful in the event of your property being lost or stolen.

**Instructions for use:**

**Permanent U.V. marker**  
Ensure surface to be marked is clean, dry and free from grease. Write the post code followed by house number or the initials of the house name. The U.V. mark resists general wear, however try to mark your property or any item you choose to mark in areas subject to the least amount of handling. It is also suitable for property, including your outdoor leisure equipment, cycle, camping equipment etc.

**Mobile phone, iPOD etc. record cards**  
Complete these record cards which you will find very useful should you have any of the items stolen.

**Set of 10 hologram security labels**  
Place these labels on your marked property to highlight the fact that you have taken additional security measures. The smallest labels are for your mobile & iPOD or such like. The long thin labels can be used on other items, printers, scanners, DVDs etc. The largest for your cycle, laptop or computer.

**Window warning label**  
This double sided printed warning label should be applied to a prominent window at the entry point of your house so as to inform visitors that your property is security marked so therefore traceable if stolen. The reverse is to remind you to take simple precautions regarding unwanted visitors.
